Mr. Abdel-Hamid Mamdouh is Senior Counsellor in the WTO's Trade in Services Division.

In his current position, Mr. Mamdouh serves as the Secretary of the WTO Council for Trade in Services and is also responsible for all legal affairs in the area of trade in services. During the Uruguay Round negotiations his responsibilities included legal matters related to drafting the General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS).

His previous positions related to the GATT include Assistant to the Deputy Director-General of the GATT and legal advisor on GATT dispute settlement. Prior to that he was a member of the Diplomatic Service of Egypt. As a career diplomat with expertise in commercial and economic affairs, his previous posts included: representative of Egypt to the GATT in Geneva, trade policy advisor to Egypt's Minister of Economy and Foreign Trade, commercial attaché of the Egyptian Embassy in Canberra (Australia), and Egypt's representative to the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa in Addis Ababa (Ethiopia).
